## MINUTES

- Update on Spring Sports (Mr. Geist)
  - Mr. Geist reviewed the entire sports year. The Fall and Winter seasons were abbreviated so therefore the postseasons were expanded. The Spring season is a full season. PIAA is looking at a "normal" spring sports playoff season as well as District 11 and the Colonial League. Everyone is following their respective Health and Safety Plans.
- Online Box Office option by HomeTown Tickets (Mr. Geist)
  - Mr. Geist showed a video of HomeTown Tickets. A number of fans and parents are traveling without cash and are requesting credit card

purchasing which is not an option. This would create an option for parents and fans to purchase tickets in advance. All fees go to the purchaser with no extra cost to the school district. For example, a person can purchase the ticket at home and print a copy or have a QR code on their phone, and present it at the gate. Mr. Geist would like to run it for the winter season and for Varsity football. The cost to the purchaser is less than a \$1.50 service fee per ticket. Mr. Geist is working with the business office, if this option is moved to the board agenda, to purchase QR code readers. It does give options for other ticketed events such as graduation, prom, musicals, etc.

- Mrs. Husack asked if this would allow the district to put a limit on tickets. Mr. Geist explained that you can assign a number of tickets to an individual player. PIAA used it for the football playoff games.
- Board members on the committee agreed to move the HomeTown Tickets option to the May board agenda.
