KEYSTONE EXAM INFORMATION

Keystone Exams will be administered on Tuesday, May 14; Thursday, May 16; and Tuesday, May 21. <u>All students will be reporting</u> at their regular time – we are NOT RUNNING on a two-hour delay schedule on testing days.

• All students should report to school at normal time and go to their homeroom. Students who are scheduled to take one or more of the Keystone Exams will have appointment cards enclosed and will do Keystone testing Module 1 in the morning and Module 2 in the afternoon. Students not involved in Keystone testing will have a normal school day!

TUESDAY, MAY 14TH

Students taking the Algebra I Keystone Exam are:

- Freshman who are currently enrolled in Honors Algebra II that have previously scored below proficient.
- Freshman and Sophomores who are currently enrolled in Academic Algebra I, Academic Algebra IB or Algebra IB who have not taken the Algebra Keystone Exam.
- Juniors who are not on the Keystone composite pathway for graduation.
- Juniors who are on the composite pathway but are choosing to retake the Keystones to gain proficiency for final exemption purposes. These students were given a letter to take home to get a parent/guardian signature to opt the student in to retake the Keystone exam. The signed form must be returned to the guidance office.

THURSDAY, MAY 16TH

Students taking the Literature Keystone Exam are:

- Sophomores and Juniors who are currently enrolled in Honors English II, Academic English II, or English II.
- Juniors who are not on the Keystone composite pathway for graduation.
- Juniors who are on the composite pathway but are choosing to retake the Keystones to gain proficiency for final exemption purposes. These students were given a letter to take home to get a parent/guardian signature to opt the student in to retake the Keystone exam. The signed form must be returned to the guidance office.

TUESDAY, MAY 21ST BIOLOGY KEYSTONE EXAM

• Juniors and any Seniors that will be re-testing.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Students are not permitted to bring electronic devices into Keystone Exam testing rooms (including mobile phones, cameras, smart phones and watches, earbuds, or any other unapproved electronic device). Any student who brings any electronic device to the testing room will be required to secure it in an envelope and submit it to the testing proctor until all students are dismissed from the testing room.
- In the event schools are closed due to weather on a Keystone testing day, an updated testing schedule will be posted on our website and/or announced via community outreach.
